Since 2021, 6 cohorts of white midwives have completed this course, including Assistant Chief Midwife Christine Cox-Jude. Their work on birth equity has inspired Kaiser Permanente Physician leaders to request this physician-specific cohort.

In consultation and collaboration with Black maternity care experts, this course is designed to change and improve your daily interactions and the care you provide to Black patients and their families.

This is an experiential course - in addition to studying historical and current causes and realities of racial inequity in maternity care in the United States, you will also (and most importantly) engage in reflection and practice designed to shift the ways you relate to and engage with patients and colleagues.
